



What's New At District Meeting And Why Should You Attend?

District Meetings are starting September 12, 2017 and run through October 26, 2017. We encourage you to attend the meetings so that you can get an update on some of the topics that will impact your pharmacy in 2018. We have multiple issues of concern this year and everyone needs to be engaged.

Responding to rising drug costs will require legislation that continues to unveil the murky business practices of PBMs and provide transparency in drug pricing. OPhA is monitoring the three Board of Pharmacy tasks forces on USP 800, Remote Order Entry, and Automation and Packaging. Escalating budget issues in Oklahoma are putting a strain on Sooner Care and the reimbursement to pharmacy. An interim study is being conducted this fall related to Medical Marijuana. Medical Marijuana is also on the 2018 ballot and we need to know where Oklahoma pharmacists stand on this issue.

These are all issues that can financially impact your pharmacy. We are coming to you and requesting your feedback on all of these issues and more. Plan to engage in some discussion and help plan and shape the legislative strategy for 2018.
