The Immunization Training Program is 20 hours total of ACPE Continuing Education, approved by the ACPE thru the APhA's website. The enrollment link will be sent to you for the 12 hours of home-study material after your registration and payment has been confirmed. The online homework is to be completed prior to the on-site 8-hour class program.**

*CPR is NOT PART of the Immunization Training Program  
You are responsible for completing CPR training prior to the classroom program or attending the CPR session offered on Friday August 2, 2024 (separate enrollment form).*

## *PROGRAM GOALS*

The goals of this 20-hour (12 hours online and 8 hours in class) ACPE approved Immunization Training Program are to:

- The impact of vaccines on public health.
- Pharmacists' roles in immunization.
- Immunologic principles of vaccine development and immunizations.
- Vaccine-preventable diseases and the vaccines used to prevent them.
- Strategies for improving immunization rates.
- Requirements for pharmacists who provide immunization services.

## *OBJECTIVES*

*At the completion of the self-study program, the participant will be able to:*

- The self-study learning activity is designed to ensure that all participants have an understanding of vaccine-preventable diseases and the role of pharmacists as vaccine advocates and administrators. There are three learning modules:
  1. Immunization Delivery Home Study
  2. Immunization Delivery Live Session Details
  3. Immunization Post Live Activity
- These modules present in-depth information on immunology, practice implementation, and legal and regulatory issues as noted below, with appropriate references to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) resource publication, Epidemiology and Prevention of Vaccine-Preventable Disease. The self-study program includes a self-assessment test and real-life case studies that are designed to help reinforce and evaluate participants' understanding of key information and concepts.

*Prepare pharmacists to:*

- Read an immunization schedule and identify appropriate vaccines for individuals across the life span and with special needs.
- Educate patients about the benefits of vaccines and dispel myths about vaccines.
- Safely administer vaccines to patients via subcutaneous, intramuscular, intranasal, and intradermal routes.
- Operate an immunization service in compliance with legal and regulatory standards.
- Partner with immunization stakeholders to promote immunizations and the immunization neighborhood.

*Direct pharmacists to resources necessary to:*

- Promote public health through immunizations.
- Access regularly updated information about vaccines and their use.
- Effectively communicate with patients and other stakeholders about resources.
- Operate an immunization service in compliance with legal and regulatory standards.

This ACPE activity does not provide a certification in this topic but rather advanced professional training which upon successful completion the learner will be able to download a certificate of achievement.

### **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT**

Program requirements include

- 1) completing the 12-hour home-study material prior to attending the on-site classroom program and completing the final, an open book quiz online with 70% or better,
- 2) participating in the entire 8-hour classroom program and
- 3) proof of your current CPR card to SWOSU College of Pharmacy Rural Health August 3, 2024.

*CPR NOTE: Although not included in Southwestern's IMMUNIZATION TRAINING PROGRAM, as part of the Program Requirements, you must provide proof of completing CPR training. CPR is NOT PART of the IMMUNIZATION TRAINING PROGRAM. You are responsible for completing CPR training prior to the classroom program.*

Upon the completion of the above requirements, you will be given an attendance code at the end of the live session, allowing you to take your final assessment, evaluation and download a Certificate of Achievement from APhA. This certificate will allow you to meet the State Board of Pharmacy requirement for Immunizations. Your 12 hours CE for the self-study homework and 8 hours for the live session will automatically upload to MYCPE monitor.

### **REGISTRATION AND FEES - SPACE IS LIMITED, SO REGISTER EARLY!**

Early registration fee of \$375 per person must be paid by July 26, 2024. After July 26, 2024, late registration fee is \$425 per person (acceptance of late registration is subject to space availability). Class size is limited to 25 pharmacists.

### **REFUNDS**

Fees are noted on the Registration page. No refunds for cancellations on or July 26, 2024. Cancellations prior to July 26<sup>th</sup> will receive a refund minus a \$50 processing fee. However, learners who redeem an enrollment code will be charged a fee of \$175 regardless of whether or not they complete any portion of the self-study. In the rare event the program is cancelled, Southwestern Oklahoma State University Rural Health Center will give registered learners the option of rolling over their prepaid registration to a future course hosted by SWOSU Rural Health Center. No refunds after July 26, 2024.
